Official Minutes of the March 2010 Dutchess County Dental Society Executive Board Meeting

The March, 2010 meeting of the DCDS Executive Board was held March 9, 2010 at Umberto's of Mamma Marissa, Poughkeepsie, NY. The meeting was called to order at 6:47 pm by President Rosemarie Mason. A quorum was determined to be present. Board members in attendance were (alphabetically): Drs. Allen Ackerman, Irving Baum, Thomas Bloom, John Costello, Stanley Kacherski, Stephen Kaplan, Armen Manasar, Mark Mason, Rosemarie Mason, Richard Rosenbloom, Michael J. Schwartz, Michael Smith, Frank Vigliotti and Mario Vilardi. Drs. Anthony Bonavoglia, Bill Kirtland, Steve Ross, and Phil Williams did not attend.

President Mason welcomed the Board. She noted with pride Dr. Tom Bloom's write up in the Ninth Bulletin, about the Players Group, and his many contributions to the Society. She discussed a letter that was circulated by Glaxo, Smith, Klein about removal of zinc from denture adhesives. Also, NYSDA is dealing with the tooth whitening kiosks and expects to have that activity phased out. The Ninth Leadership Conference is set for June 2nd.

The minutes of the February 2010 Executive Board meeting were accepted as previously distributed.

Secretary Steve Ross was unable to report due to his absence as a result of injury earlier in the day. Notes were kept by Dr. Schwartz this evening.

Treasurer Stephen Kaplan reported that the DCDS remains in good financial condition. Dr. Kaplan said that several members have not yet paid dues. We have sent a check for \$200 as our annual contribution to the DC Regional Science Fair. Several advertisers have been slow to pay for their ads in the Bulletin.

Membership Committee Chairman Michael Smith reported that there is a new member application pending.

Bulletin Committee Chairman Rich Rosenbloom reported that the deadline for the April Bulletin is March 13th.

Program Committee Chairman Allen Ackerman reported that the rest of the year's General Membership Meeting programming is complete.

Nominating Committee Chairman Ackerman reported that the proposed slate of nominees is nearly ready for presentation to the Board next month. It was agreed to form Committees for each position, instead of a single individual having the only knowledge of how an Office functions. Thus, for Treasurer, the Committee is headed by Dr. Kaplan, with Dr. Rosenbloom being the Committee member. For Secretary, Dr. Ross will head the Committee and Dr. Schwartz and Kirtland will serve as members. The purpose will be to insure that there can and will be members able to succeed the Chairman, if needed. Dr. Schwartz suggested that the best time to present the Board to new members is at their application process, by requiring them to make a personal appearance. If not done at that time, a golden opportunity is lost. That concept was accepted by the Board.

Dr. Mark Mason reported that no new **Member Benefits** have been arranged since the last report.

Reporting for the **Major CE Events Committee**, Dr. Rose Mason reported that a successful walk through was done at Villa Borghese, Thus far, nearly half of the registrants have signed up via the online route. Another e-mail blast has been sent and another will follow. An e-mail will be sent to all registrants with complete directions to the venue and additional information.

DCDS Sweatshirt orders are ready to be taken. An e-mail blast will publicize the sweatshirts and members will be directed to Dr. Bloom for orders. Orders will also be taken at the April General Membership Meeting.

DCDS pins: Dr. Mark Mason reported that pins are being created and should cost about \$1.35. A motion to purchase pins with the DCDS logo and the 9th District numeral 9, for distribution to all DCDS members was unanimously passed.

Dutchess County Dental Society Players Director Tom Bloom announced that the last performance of this season will be 5/14 at the Evans School on Old Route Nine in Wappingers Falls.

Helping Hand Partnership Committee: Dr. Costello reported that no requests for assistance were received since the last meeting, a good thing.

Dutchess County Science Fair: Dr. Manasar reported that the fair will be held Saturday, April 10th.

Schools and National Children's Dental Health Month Committee Chairman Stan Kacherski reported that 90-100 posters were judged with 30 winners. Prizes will be available shortly for distribution. Dr. Kacherski was commended for his Committee's success.

Hall of Fame Committee Chairman Michael Schwartz reported that the recipient of the 2010 Award has been notified and he has

accepted and will be writing his biography, as requested by the Committee. The Plaque is ready for order, and all arrangements are in place for the ceremony.

Ninth District's Executive Committee: Under the newly adopted rule limiting reporting of our Representatives to the Ninth District's Executive Committee, Board of Governors, Councils and Committees to matters that directly affect the Dutchess County Dental Society, there was no report on the proceedings of the Ninth's Executive Committee.

Ninth District's Board of Governors: Dr. Mark Mason reported on discussions at the Ninth's BOG in regard to licensure for dental anesthesia residents, the stature of limitations bill, which is stalled in the NYS Assembly, Medicaid funds which may be partially restored in the budget, and that Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons are seeking to have the scope of their practice include facial plastic surgery. He stressed the statewide need for Donated Dental Services volunteers.

Audit, Budget, Finance and Management Committee: Dr. Baum reported that the lower floor of the Headquarters Building is unrented and a tenant is being sought, and that bids are out for siding the building.

Good & Welfare: The Executive Board congratulated Dr. Baum on his grandson's acceptance to Rutgers University.

All business having been concluded, and on proper motion, the meeting was adjourned at 8:09 pm. The next meeting of the Executive Board is April 13, 2010 at a place to be determined.

The Secretary acknowledges with thanks for the assistance of Dr. Schwartz in the preparation of these minutes.
