# "Yes We Still Have Teeth"

The explosion of dental implants has, in some respects, placed the preservation of the natural dentition and state of health on the back burner. Years of personal experience and current literature will support the concept that teeth severely involved with periodontal disease and/or caries can be maintained for decades. Modern periodontal therapy has evolved to the point where the ability to create soft tissue, regenerate bone as well as maintain previously diseased teeth has become predictable. We've had a tendency to throw out the baby with the bathwater. There are traditional technologies such as scaling and root planing, the use of targeted antibiotics both systematically and locally, the use of the periscope for visualization during scaling and a myriad of surgical procedures that have enabled many teeth that have been and will be extracted to be preserved in a state of health. This lecture will cover the historical trends and current approaches to preserving the natural dentition.
