DCDS Executive Board Meeting

Tuesday, May 21st 6:30

Call to Order

Dr. Rosenbloom opened the meeting at 6:32pm and welcomed everyone. We continued the discussion (started through email) regarding non-tripartite membership regulations and proposed fees.

Officers' Reports

Membership Committee- Dr. Michael Smith spoke with Stephen from the 9th district in regard to allowing our branch society to have 20% nonmembers (similar to study club regulations). The approval has to go through the ninth bylaws committee and then it will go to the August executive board meeting. Following the executive board meeting, it will then go to the September BOG meeting. For now, we will continue under the assumption that this will be approved. We currently have ~10-15% non tripartite members. Will the 9th still print CE's for non tripartite members? We will also need bylaws to include the new classification of non tripartite members (no voting rights). We plan to initiate this at the start of 2025.

Treasurer: Dr. Richard Rosenbloom recommends 2 types of memberships (one for tripartite members and one for non- tripartite members). The tripartite members will continue to not have a membership fee as they already pay into the tripartite, however, for the non tripartite members, there will now be a membership fee of \$100-\$150. Non tripartite members will be a separate category of memberships (one for

tripartite members and one for non- tripartite members). The tripartite members will continue to not have a membership fee as they already pay into the tripartite, however, for the non tripartite members, there will now be a membership fee of \$100-\$150. Non tripartite members will be a separate category of membership and will have a season ticket option that is still discounted, however, not as much of a discount compared to tripartite members. It was suggested that the non tripartite season ticket is ~\$250, however, this still needs to be finalized. Our wording should state that we “currently” offer no membership fees for our tripartite members (in case that changes in the future). Dr. Richard Rosenbloom reported the fiscal year ends May 31 - be sure to submit any reimbursements prior to that.

Steward- Dr. Michael Wiener was absent. We reviewed that so far we have 15 sign ups for the June meeting (including one staff member)

Program Committee- Dr. Ali Payami informed us that the speaker for the September meeting will be Dr. Aaron Yancoskie, Dean of Toro and maxillofacial oral-pathologist.

Old Business/New Business- We approved to add an executive board meeting for 5/13/2025
